Famous events were also commemorated through pottery design – such as the Olympic games, which originated in Ancient Greece.

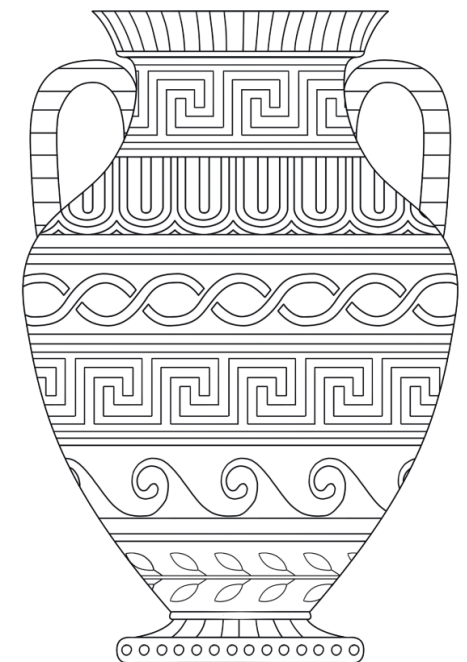
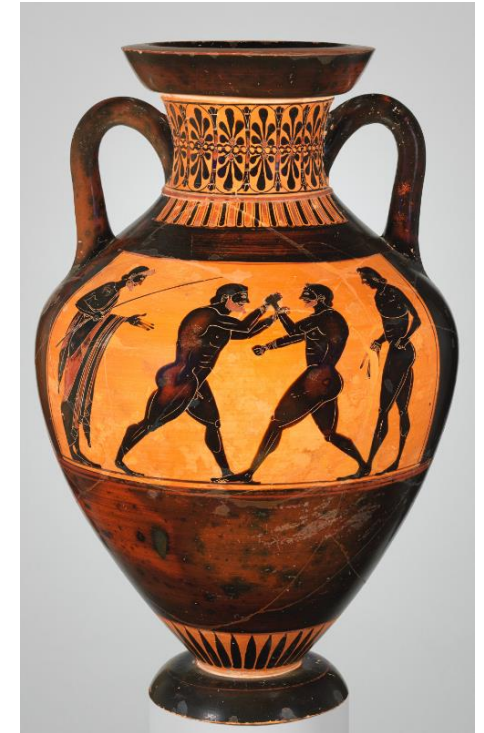
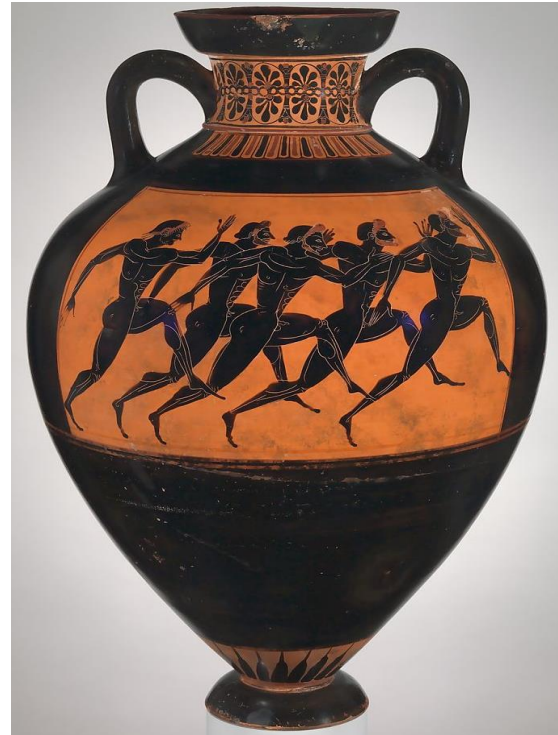
Traditional pottery was painted black onto an orange glaze to give that distinctive colouring to Ancient Greek pottery.
