- 1) Disco- just need to confirm the date that we've chosen. Discussion was had about the possibility of doing two discos on two different dates. Group decided it would be easier to have it all in one night. This way it would mean getting one entertainer, one night of helpers etc. Reception/KS1 would be 6-7pm and KS2 will be 7.15 until 8.45. The date of the 22<sup>nd</sup> was decided as it would be the final full week of term. Reception children's parents would have to stay and **Carole to find out the ratios needed for adults to children for the disco. Tracy to message entertainer and book them.** We are to hold a tuck shop there and have glow sticks to sell. Permission slips to be done electronically via parent mail before hand, although spare paper copies will be available if someone forgets to submit one. Price of £2.50 per child. School to transfer the money to PTA account when all collected. **Carole to find out about the possibility of getting a red carpet.** A suggestion was made for the PTA to pay for the year 6's entry for the disco as a goodbye gift from the PTA. - 7) Year 6 Cap & Gowns- Mr Seviour asked if the PTA would pay £60 for a selection of cap and gowns for the year 6 leaving assembly/photos. PTA agreed.
- 8) School Newsletter – Tracy submitted a piece from the PTA for the last the patient newsletter but it was not put in. Carole explained the cut of dates for items to added to the news letter.
