

Activity Clubs – Summer Term 2026

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to share our plans for Activity Clubs for the Summer Term. Following the success of the clubs last term I hope the children will engage in these new experiences. These clubs are in addition to extra-curricular activities already offered by the school, including SASP events.

The details of clubs on offer are in the table below. Club places will go live on Arbor **on Saturday 28th of March at 1800 and close on Wednesday 22nd April 2026 at 1800**. This is to allow all Parents and Carers time to book.

Places are offered on a first come, first served basis. Once both payment and consent have been given your place will then be secure. Consent alone does not secure your booking.

Club dates will be:

Starting week commencing the 27th of April 2026 through until the week ending the 15th of May 2026 (3 weeks)

Starting week commencing the 2nd of June 2026 through until the week ending the 3rd of July 2026 (5 weeks)

Please see below table detailing each club and how long they are running for.

All clubs run from 3:15pm – 4:15pm. The charge will be £2.20 per session, per child.

Please Note:

Running Club is only running for the first 3 weeks.

Payment

Steps to follow:

1. Login into your Arbor App/Account
2. From the Dashboard, click on '**Quick Actions**'
3. Select '**Clubs**' where you will be able to **register your child** for the relevant club and **give your consent and make payment**. Please note, your child will not be able to attend without your consent and payment.
4. Follow the steps, in order to **select the 'period of membership'** and then either press: '**make payment**' or '**add to basket**' (should you have other payments to make, e.g. meals).
5. Then go back and select 'payment's off the left-hand menu, where you can view any payments and your balance and if needed '**top up account**'.

Reminder:

After School Club (Kingfisher) – Important Booking Information

- If you have booked your child into **After School Club (Kingfisher)**, it is **your responsibility to cancel** if your child will not be attending.
- Cancellations must be made **at least 24 hours in advance** by contacting the school office **via email**. If you do not cancel, you will still be charged.

After Activity Clubs

- If your child attends an after-school activity club and you require childcare afterwards, you can book an **After Activity Club session** via Arbor.
- If you have already booked a full After School Club session but now only need the After Activity Club session, please:
 1. Email the school office to cancel the full After School Club session.
 2. Rebook the **After Activity Club session only** through Arbor.

Behaviour expectations at our activity club sessions are the same as during school time, children who display consistent disruptive behaviour may be asked to leave the club.

We hope the children will enjoy the extra activities offered for the Summer Term.
